Guidelines for Oral Presentation

1. Oral Session Presenters should use either PowerPoint or PDF presentations.
2. Presentations for allotted sessions have to be loaded in the allocated venues before 30 minutes.
3. Kindly bring in your presentations in a CD-ROM or a USB Storage Device
4. Oral presentations are organized into “sessions” with a common theme
5. All presenting authors are expected to be present at the time their session begins, and to remain for the entire session.
6. Each oral presenter will be introduced and the title of your talk will be read by the Session Chairman
7. The oral presenter will be given 10 minutes for the talk
8. A warning signal will be given after 6 minutes of the talk to notify the time restriction.
9. If you try to go over the maximum time allotted, the Session Chairman holds the right to interrupt you to announce that your time is up.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

1. The poster session will be held at the Ground floor, International Research Centre, Sathyabama University, Chennai.
2. **Posters can be displayed on all the three days of the conference.**
3. The size of the poster should be restricted to a maximum of **1m (Height) × 1 m (Width)**
4. All poster material should be confined to the space provided
5. Your poster presentation should not exceed the surface space provided
6. The title of the paper, author names and affiliation should be printed at the top of the poster
7. Posters should be mounted on pre-numbered boards marked by Poster ID
8. Presenters should display posters **ONLY on the assigned Poster ID**
9. The poster should be displayed in such a way that the Poster ID displayed on the board should be visible
10. Posters should be readable from five feet away. The poster should be understandable without oral explanation
11. Double sided tape and board pins will be made available for each poster board. Please contact the poster committee help desk on the venue.
12. Posters should be displayed on July 10th, 2015
13. Poster background should be preferably be light colour and font in dark colour for better clarity
14. The presenting author should be available at their allotted locations during the poster session.
